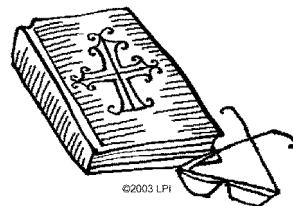

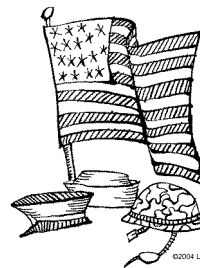

**ORDINARY TIME:** Apart from those seasons having their own distinctive character, there remains in the yearly cycle those weeks (33 or 34) that do not celebrate a specific mystery of Christ. Rather, especially on Sundays, they are devoted to the Mystery of Christ in all its fullness. This period is known as **Ordinary Time**, which is from January 10 until Ash Wednesday, & resumes at the end of the Easter season until Advent.
