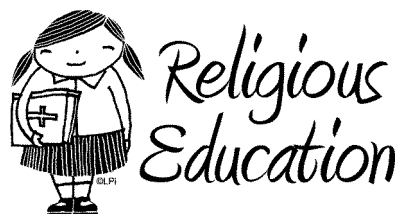
**CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES – PAKISTAN:**

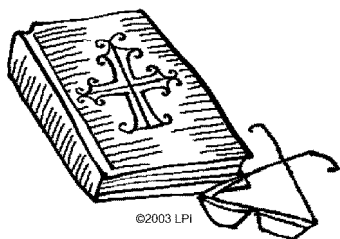
