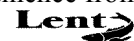

THE NOVENA OF THE MIRACULOUS MEDAL: is prayed every Tuesday after the 9 a.m. Mass.

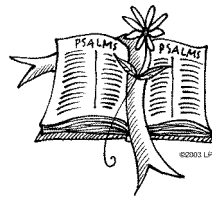

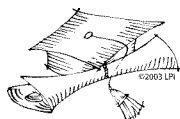
