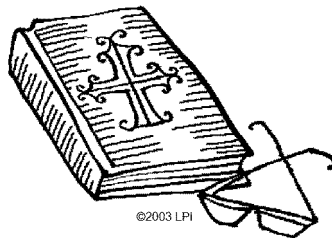
NOVENA TO THE MIRACULOUS MEDAL: is prayed Every Tuesday following the 9 a.m. Mass.

Trinity Sunday

"Glory be to the Father, & to the Son, & to the Holy Spirit," is a familiar doxology for Catholics. The mystery of the Trinity is central to the Christian faith. The identification of the Three Persons of the Trinity can be traced through the Old Testament, the New Testament and in the writings of the early Church fathers and ecumenical councils. Yet, there was no universal celebration of this mystery until the fourteenth century. At that time Pope John XXII ordered the feast for the Latin Church. The Sunday after Pentecost has been designated as Trinity Sunday in the Western Church. The Eastern Church has no special feast to honor the Trinity
