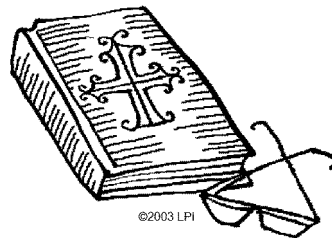

**NOVENA TO THE MIRACULOUS MEDAL:** is prayed every Tuesday following the 9 a.m. Mass.



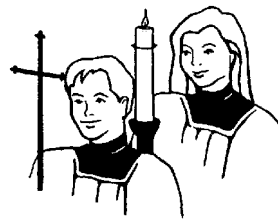
**CHOWDER-FEST 2010:**
