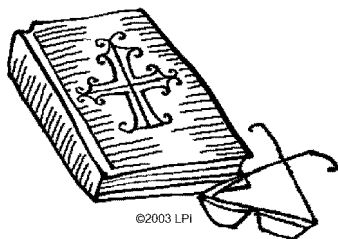
**WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE INVOLVED IN OUR PARISH MUSIC MINISTRY?**
